Definition

A community care package is a planned and coordinated package of community care services assigned to assist a person who requires management of services due to their complex needs.

A community care package is targeted at frail older people living in the community. These people would otherwise be eligible for low dependent residential care.

Hostel level of care is generally for people aged 60 years and over.
